DAY 1 EMBARK LAVRIO
Embarkation : 17.00 pm from Lavrio Port, Attica.

DAY 2 LAVRIO - KEA
The island of Kea (aka Tzia) is a charming Cycladic island with age-old traditions and interesting history. Its landscape will catch your attention with its green fields, high hills, vineyards, olive groves, ravines, coves and secluded beaches. Visit the largest oak forest in the Cyclades and keep an eye out for the rich bird fauna. Explore its numerous caves (Trypospilies Cave at Kalamos, Agios Timotheos Cave, and Agios Panteleimonas Cave) and the mining area at Orkou. Follow the 81 km paths and discover four ancient city-states of the island (Ioulida - Karthaia - Korissia - Poieessa). Kea is a famous sailing destination mainly due to its proximity to Attica. Its waters are great for divers as a large number of shipwrecks reside on the sea bottom.

DAY 3 KEA - SYROS
Syros Island combines culture, entertainment and religion in the most harmonious way. It used to be one of the most significant islands in Cycladic civilisation. Nowadays, the island is world-renowned for its rich cultural tradition with a large variety of events that take place in Ermoupolis, the island's capita. The island offers a large variety of sea activities and beaches for you to enjoy, as well as delicious and varied cuisine to indulge in.

DAY 4 SYROS - MYKONOS
What makes this island special is that it can cover a variety of demands: you can visit it for its archaeological sites; get to know the local traditions in its picture-perfect villages; and you can explore its amazing beaches, considered by many as the top ones in the Aegean Sea. Chora is quite an impressive and picturesque Cycladic town. For a taste of culture and history, take a boat trip to nearby Delos Island; it's a big and impressive archaeological site.

DAY 5 MYKONOS - PAROS
Discover the great beauty of Paros. Walk along the long beaches with crystal-clear waters and bask in its impressive landscapes. In antiquity, Paros was famous for its white marble quarries; the so-called 'Parian marble' was highly sought-after for its top quality, for use in architecture and sculpture, including the Acropolis in Athens. The island has known periods of great prosperity, as shown by the ruins in its archaeological sites and its considerable historical monuments, which you can visit across the island.

DAY 6 PAROS - KYTHNOS
Despite its proximity to Attica's coast, Kythnos is one of the lesser-known islands in the Cyclades. The southern part is practically uninhabited, and in the north you find Merichas and the island's harbour, as well as Chora or Mesaria (the island capital), Loutra and Dryopida. Kythnos wears the standard blue and white colours of the Cyclades, its countryside is dotted with hills, dry-stone walls that stretch for kilometres ahead and more than 350 snow white little chapels scattered around the island. It has more than 65 beaches (the majority ending in off-road access tracks) and picturesque villages with the narrow-cobbled streets, the white-washed houses, squares, churches and windmills.

DAY 1	<p>MYKONOS - ANTIPAROS</p> <p>Embarkation : 10.00 am from Kalo Livadi Bay</p> <p>Set off this morning from Kalo Livadi Bay to start your exclusive week-long private yacht charter. Leaving Mykonos behind, cruise towards the island of Antiparos. The first swim stop of the day is at Panderonissi, affectionately known as the Blue lagoon due to its mesmerizing azure water. Afterwards, visit the natural caves in the island of Despotiko, an uninhabited island southwest from Antiparos, followed by a fresh seafood lunch. Enjoy your first night docked at Antiparos.</p>
DAY 2	<p>ANTIPAROS - PANO KOUFONISSIA (FINIKAS)</p> <p>Begin the day at leisure and enjoy the onboard facilities of your yacht. The main activity today is snorkelling at Agia Andreas, where its possible to visit the plane wreck here. Located in the southwest of Iraklia, in the beautiful bay of Alimnia, at a depth of about 9 meters/929 feet, the remains of a German World War II seaplane of World War II can be found. When the weather is good, it can be seen from the surface of the sea, since the crystal-clear waters reveal it immediately. After lunch, head towards Pano Koufonisia and unwind overnight docked near the shore.</p>
DAY 3	<p>PANO KOUFONISSIA (FINIKAS) - AMORGOS KATAPOLA</p> <p>Cruise to Antikeros to enjoy a swimming stop before setting out for towards Amorgos Katapola port. Visit the famous monastery Chozoviotissa (land transportation needed) and enjoy dinner in Chora village. Relax at Amorgos Katapola.</p>
DAY 4	<p>AMORGOS KATAPOLA - SANTORINI</p> <p>Today's first leisurely stop is a swim at Manganiari. Enjoy time here in the beautiful water before continuing to the striking island of Santorini, passing by the volcanic area "Palea Kameni". Enjoy a stop at Amoudi Bay for lunch at a typical Greek tavern and visit the iconic village of Oia. Tonight, enjoy a relaxing evening docked in Santorini.</p>
DAY 5	<p>SANTORINI - MILOS</p> <p>Leave Santorini behind and travel to the stunning island of Milos, enjoying a morning swim stop at Kleftiko Bay to explore the crystal-clear waters and unique landscape. Lunch is on board today followed by a visit to Milos' main town. Relax at Adamandas, Milos tonight.</p>
DAY 6	<p>MILOS - SIFNOS</p> <p>Your first stop this morning is Poliegos so you can enjoy a swim in the blissful waters here. Afterwards, set course to Kimolos island. (Psathi port). The final destination of the day is Sifnos island, arriving into port just before sunset. Unwind this evening and enjoy the facilities onboard at Vathi Sifnos island.</p>
DAY 7	<p>SIFNOS - MYKONOS</p> <p>The first stop of the day is Fikiada for a swim stop. If you'd like, there is the opportunity to have lunch at Omega 3 (Plati Gialos). In the afternoon, the course is set to return to Mykonos. If you would like, along the way a stop can be made to visit Delos or Rhenia islands. Enjoy dinner at a beach bar restaurant accessible by boat (Solymar beach bar restaurant, Jackie O, to mention a few) or, alternatively, visit Mykonos Chora for an evening tour and dinner.</p>
DAY 8	<p>MYKONOS</p> <p>Disembarkation Mykonos: 09.00 am</p>
