DAY 1	<p>ARRIVE SPLIT</p> <p>On arrival to Split airport you will be met by your Guardian Angel and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is yours to explore the atmosphere of the city at leisure.</p>
DAY 2	<p>SPLIT</p> <p>Meet your private guide and immerse yourself in the fascinating history of Split during a morning tour which begins with an exploration of the impressive Diocletian's Palace. Built in 295 AD, this extraordinary structure lies in the heart of the city forming part of the old town and city centre, making Split one of the most unique cities in Europe. See Peristil Square where the Emperor made his speeches, as well as the mausoleum of the Roman Emperor, which was transformed into a Catholic church in the 7th century AD. At the end of your tour, you may wish to take a stroll along the Riva, a chic coastal promenade lined with palm trees, where you can relax in the sun and enjoy a beautiful view of the port and nearby islands.</p>
DAY 3	<p>PRIVATE YACHT SPLIT-HVAR</p> <p>Today you will be met at your hotel by your English-speaking driver and privately transferred to Split port to board Velasco 43F motor-yacht. Begin sailing out of Split and explore the iconic island of Hvar and the wonderful Pakleni Islands which are a paradise for lovers of unspoiled nature, beautiful sandy coves and crystal-clear waters. Your next destination is the beautiful island of Korčula, one of Croatia's most attractive towns and steeped in history.</p>
DAY 4	<p>PRIVATE YACHT HVAR-KORCULA</p> <p>Today enjoy your day on board your Velasco 43F motor-yacht. Your next destination is the beautiful island of Korčula, one of Croatia's most attractive towns and steeped in history. Korčula is acclaimed to be the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo and offers visitors a charming old town with an abundance of excellent restaurants. The impressive old fortress, quaint cobbled streets and astounding natural beauty make Korčula is an idyllic place to spend an evening. The island is abundant in olive groves and vineyards and the southern part of the island is formed by small quiet beaches and private coves.</p>
DAY 5	<p>PRIVATE YACHT KORCULA-DUBROVNIK</p> <p>Today enjoy your day on board your Velasco 43F motor-yacht. Your next destination is the UNESCO-listed city of Dubrovnik, known as the 'Pearl of the Adriatic' that has provided the backdrop to many feature-length films. Easily one of the world's most beautiful walled cities, Dubrovnik's baroque architecture, striking red roof houses and luxurious marble streets will capture your hearts. Walk the magnificent medieval city walls for amazing sea views; don't miss the cable car ride to Mt Srd and witness the incredible panorama from above.</p>
DAY 6	<p>DUBROVNIK</p> <p>Explore Dubrovnik's rich architectural heritage on a half-day walking tour through its historic old town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often referred to as a living city museum. Begin your walk along the centuries-old main thoroughfare, Stradun, lined with landmarks that narrate the city's history. Discover the 14th-century Franciscan Monastery, home to a beautiful cloister and one of the oldest functioning pharmacies in Europe. Conclude your exploration at the grand Rector's Palace and the Dominican Monastery, both architectural gems from the 14th century that echo the era when Dubrovnik's city walls were first constructed.</p>
DAY 7	<p>DEPART DUBROVNIK</p> <p>Today you are privately transferred to Dubrovnik Airport for your departure flight.</p>
