- Take a one-hour balloon flight over towering baobab trees and herds of elephants

# Bwind Impenetrable Forest

- Track the endangered mountain gorilla there are only about 1100 of them in the world - and spend an hour in their presence
- Set out on an Akorn Insider Access experience - canoeing down the river with a sundowner finale - for the best views of the mountain ranges
- Go behind the scenes at the Karisoke Research Center, set up by Diane Fossey, and meet the researchers protecting this incredible species

- Visit an authentic Himba village and meet the tribespeople to get a taste of their lives and culture
- Enjoy a river cruise on the Kunene River and spot plenty of crocodiles, as well as native birds and plant life
- Walking safaris puts the scale of this epic landscape in perspective. Enjoy a magical early-morning trek along one of the mountain chains that enclose and protect the Marienfluss Valley
