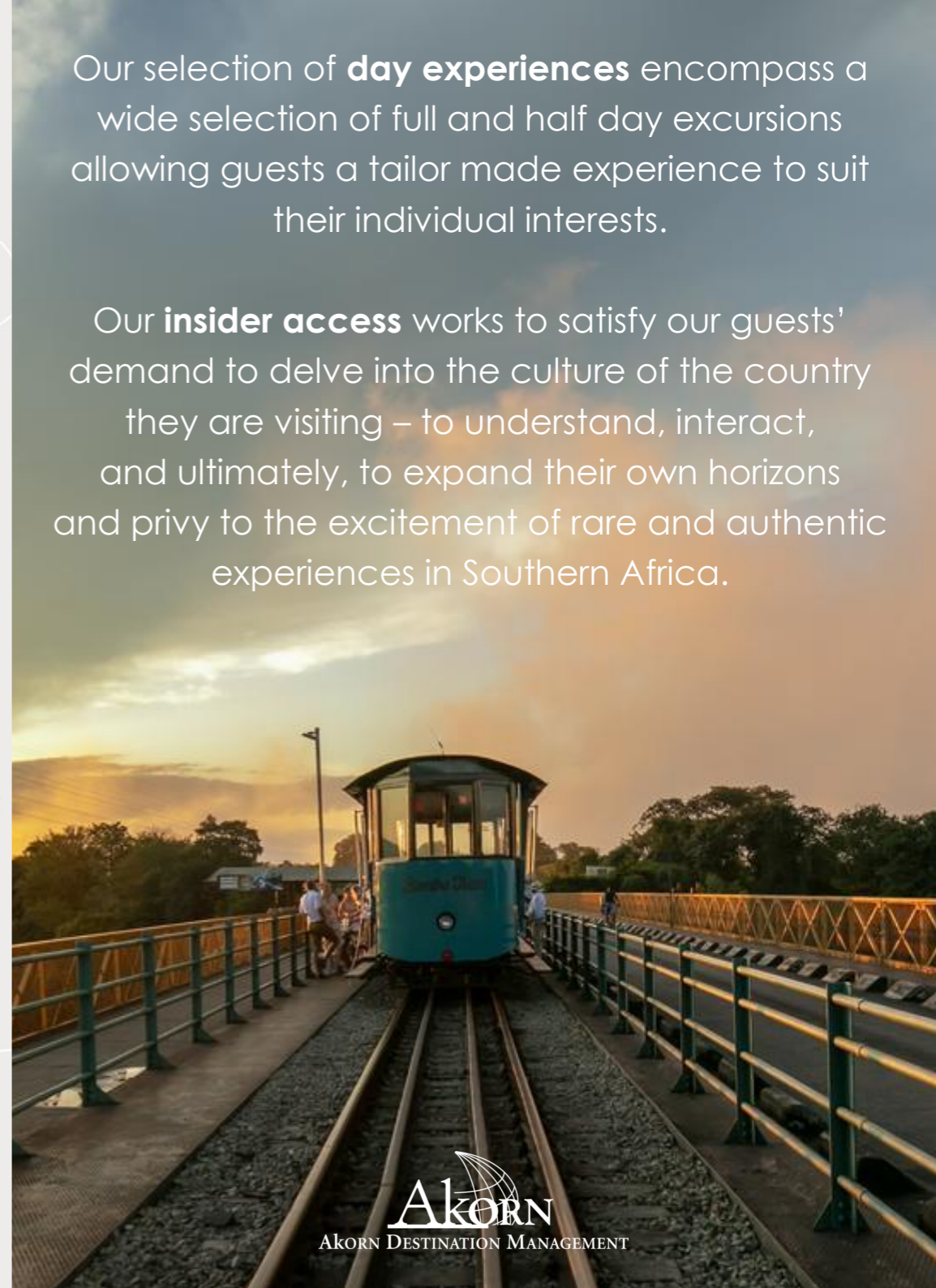

## Historic Tram & Tour of the Falls

As the tram winds its way through the national park near the Falls, it offers a sweeping view of the African bush, providing an opportunity to observe the local wildlife. The journey progresses towards the border, crossing into Zambia and passing to the Victoria Falls Bridge. Enjoy the scenery of Victoria Falls, the gorge, and the Zambezi River below. The tour also includes a visit to the rail and bridge museum, featuring an informative talk on the area's history, the railway, and the bridge. Light refreshments are provided on the bridge itself. Following this exhilarating experience, proceed to the entrance of Victoria Falls, where you'll disembark and commence your guided tour of the impressive waterfall followed by lunch at the Lookout Café.



## Village and Bio Gas Tour

Engage with the village chief or household head, gaining insights into their way of life and traditions. Delve into the intricacies of daily village life, discover unique projects led by women, and explore the innovative Biogas Plant. The head of the household will provide a detailed explanation of its functioning and the societal benefits it offers. Witness the process of biogas production through anaerobic digestion, yielding high-quality cooking fuel and a nutrient-rich slurry suitable for fertilizing fields. Conclude your visit with a delightful cup of tea shared with the local family. The entire tour is expected to last approximately two hours and 30 minutes.

## Tour of the Falls

Guests also get an opportunity to do some curio shopping in the adjacent open-air markets before returning their hotel.

## Flight of Angels

Enjoy an unforgettable helicopter journey comprising of four circuits (two on either side) offering unrivalled and spectacular views and photographic opportunities while putting the full breadth and height of The Falls into perspective within the surrounding environment.



## Zambezi Royal Sunset Cruise

The Zambezi Royal is a luxurious cruise boat, offering a unique and intimate way to view the Zambezi River. ## Zambezi Dinner Malachite Cruise

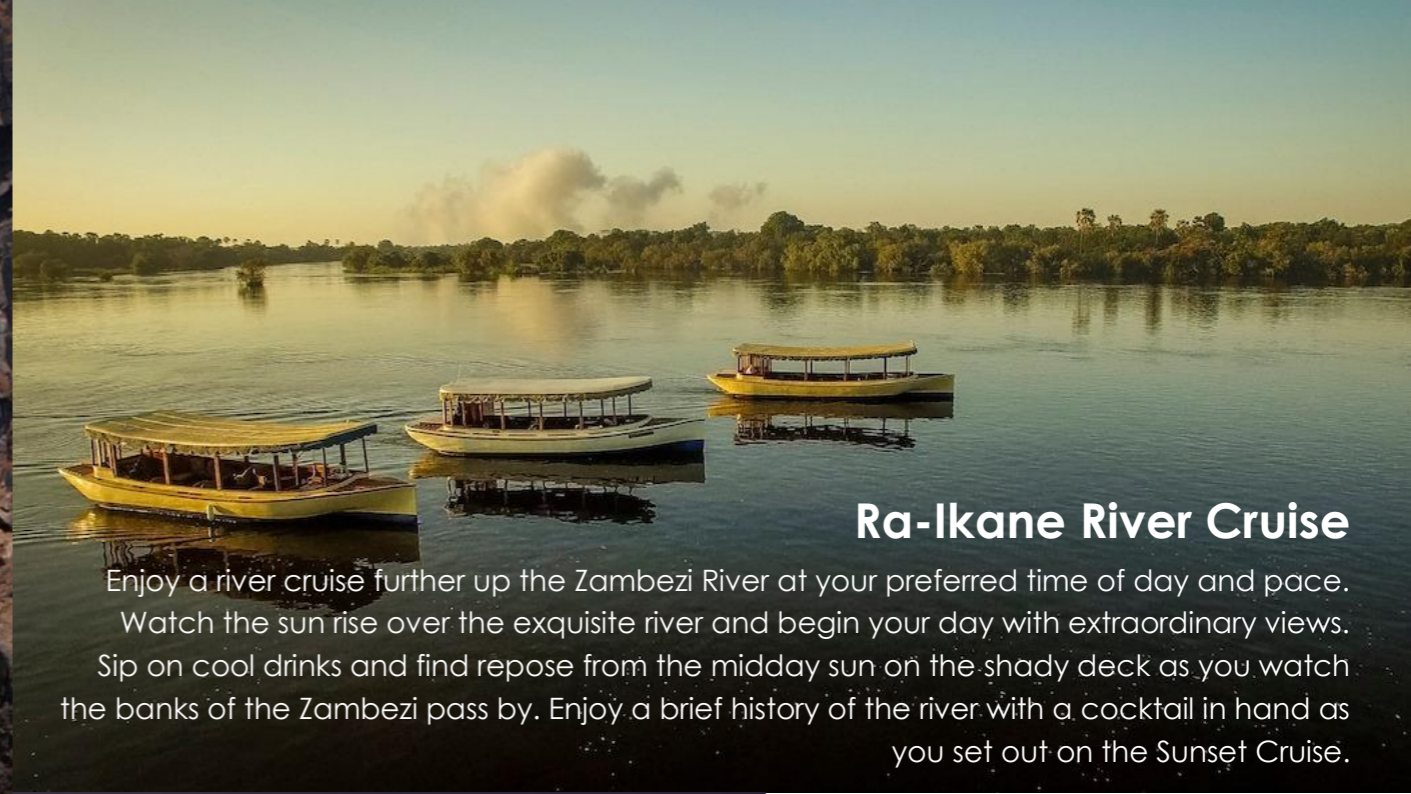
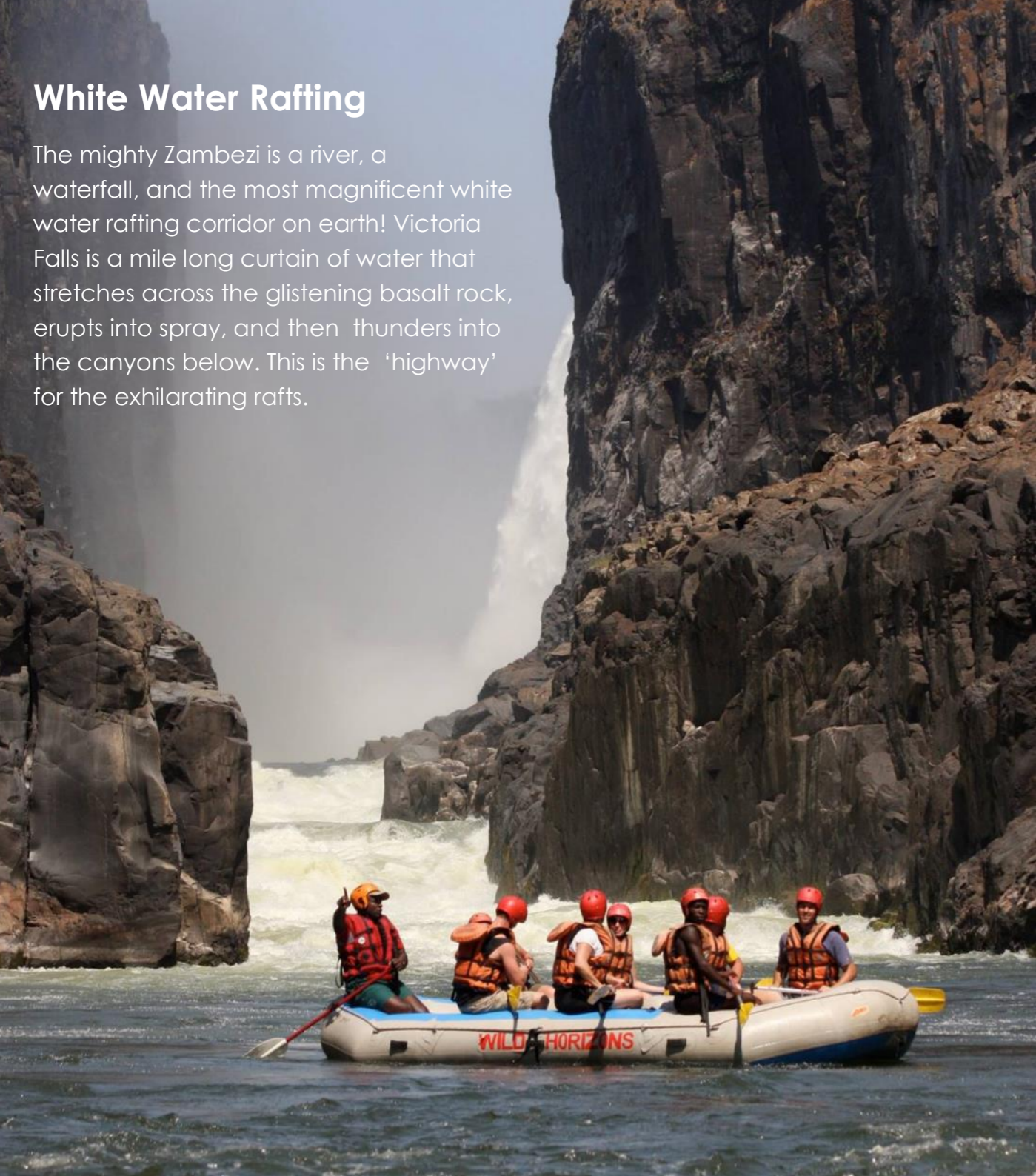

Like the exquisite bird after which it was named "Malachite" is one of the Zambezi River's crowing gems. ## White Water Rafting

The mighty Zambezi is a river, a waterfall, and the most magnificent white water rafting corridor on earth! Victoria Falls is a mile long curtain of water that stretches across the glistening basalt rock, erupts into spray, and then thunders into the canyons below. This is the 'highway' for the exhilarating rafts.



## Ra-Ikane River Cruise

Enjoy a river cruise further up the Zambezi River at your preferred time of day and pace. Watch the sun rise over the exquisite river and begin your day with extraordinary views. Sip on cool drinks and find repose from the midday sun on the shady deck as you watch the banks of the Zambezi pass by. Enjoy a brief history of the river with a cocktail in hand as you set out on the Sunset Cruise.

## Lunar Tour

Lunar rainbows, also known as 'moon bows', are rainbows that take place at night, when a rainbow is seen in the light of the moon. Victoria Falls is one of a very limited number of sites around the world, which are known for the occurrence of moon bows. The lunar rainbow is a spectacular event that can be seen only during the full moon. The Lunar rainbow tour is conducted over a period of three days, during full moon at the Victoria Falls.





## Victoria Falls Bicycle Tour

Victoria Falls is brimming with craft markets, enticing restaurants and an array of shops. Explore this exciting town, cycle along the Zambezi River, visit the famous Big Tree (a baobab tree estimated to 3500 years old), enjoy spectacular views of the Batoka Gorges below the Falls and cycle across the Victoria Falls Bridge.



## Home Hosted Lunch

Families will welcome you into their homes for a fee and provide you with a traditional meal. Experience the true flavours of Victoria Falls with a "home cooked meal". A short transfer takes you to the Chinotimba High Density suburb, here you will be hosted by a local family in their residence and served a traditional African home made lunch.



## Meet the People

Guests are taken to an authentic rural village approximately 20 kilometres (12 miles) from Victoria Falls town where they are given the opportunity to see and interact with local villagers going about their daily tasks. Have a first hand glimpse into real rural life, visiting rural homes, watching fields being tended and possibly getting the chance to help in some of the day-to-day chores.
