Our Focus: Education, Healthcare, Conservation and Enterprise

Deepalaya Education Centre, Delhi

Since 1979, Deepalaya has been providing quality education to underprivileged children in marginalized communities.

- Our contributions:
 - Sponsored 125 students, covering tuition, health check-ups, and extracurriculars.
 - Donated 75 benches and educational materials for 150 students.
 - Supplied protein supplements to 450 students, improving their BMI.



Princess Diya Kumari Foundation, Jaipur

The Princess Diya Kumari Foundation (PDKF) empowers women and girls by addressing cultural, gender, and economic barriers.

Through Project Baala, it provides reusable menstrual pads and promotes sustainable hygiene, reaching 5,600 beneficiaries through workshops and campaigns.

Our contribution: We have trained 9 Menstrual Champions who now lead training sessions, outreach programs, and distribute menstrual pads, ensuring access to sustainable hygiene products for women and girls in underserved communities.



Maharana of Mewar Charitable Foundation, Udaipur

Founded in 1969 by the Maharana of Udaipur, MMCF focuses on heritage preservation, academics, eco-management, and philanthropy. Through MMCF, we support two schools in Udaipur.

- Our contributions:
 - Hansraj Children's Home: Sponsored clothes, stationery, and food for 60 students.
 - Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School: Sponsored 10 computers with WI-FI. Refurbished 13 classrooms with repairs and fresh paint.

Healthcare: Deepalaya Education Centre, Delhi

In an endeavor to have long-term goals with quantifiable results in healthcare and education of children at the Deepalaya School, we would be pursuing the following:

- Nutrition program - Work on nutrition of about 500 students. This will help with alleviating the BMI of the students.
- Nutrition education workshops for parents of the students.



Entrepreneurship: Princess Diya Kumari Foundation, Jaipur

A key initiative of PDKF is 'Project Shakti' which was launched with the idea of creating equal opportunities for women and girls by offering free and certified courses.

We will establish a new cluster for 'Project Shakti' to provide sewing training to women from the rural part of Jaipur. 100-120 women are expected to benefit from the project in the first year.



Conservation: Tiger Watch, Ranthambhore np

As predators approach human settlements, livestock depredation causes economic losses and strains relations between communities and conservation efforts.

We have partnered with Tiger Watch to launch a cattle compensation program in Ranthambore national park, offering quick financial relief for livestock losses and promoting positive community involvement in conservation.



Skill development: Digantar Vidyalaya, Jaipur

Digantar Vidyalaya (school), focuses on alternative education and holistic child development.

We have partnered with Digantar to launch a skill development program, teaching students sewing, plumbing, and electrical work, enabling them to learn valuable vocations while completing their studies.

We are also sponsoring infrastructure upgrade at the school.
