






A Family Journey Through Nature and Wonder

Uncover Buenos Aires' vibrant street art with an expert guide, then create your own Porteño-inspired design in a fun graffiti workshop for all the family.




POLO LESSONS




Visit the stunning Salinas

views and fresh air.








ISLA EXPERIENCE

SNOW ACTIVITIES



GREAT ADVENTURE

Embark on a thrilling motorboat journey along the Lower Iguazú River, gliding past lush subtropical scenery and navigating through rapids en route to Garganta del Diablo—the Devil's Throat. Expect a splash and an unforgettable perspective of one of South America's most iconic natural wonders.



JUNGLE & KAYAK

FLY PARK



The center offers a unique opportunity to explore the natural habitat of Misiones and gain insight into the efforts to rehabilitate and return wildlife to their native environment. Visit the rescue center's facilities to observe firsthand the ongoing care of species such as toucans, parrots, owls and larger mammals.

SAN LORENZO PENGUIN COLONY

Discover Estancia San
Lorenzo, a traditional
Patagonian ranch and home
to the world's largest colony
of Magellanic penguins.
Explore the rookery, then
continue to Punta Norte
Reserve, where seasonal
wildlife sightings may
include sea lions, elephant
seals and even orcas.



TONINAS WATCH-ING ADVENTURE

Toninas (Commerson's dolphins) are among the world's smallest and most striking dolphins, often likened to miniature orcas with their distinctive black head, fins and tail contrasting against a bright white body. Playa Unión is one of the rare and privileged places where you can embark on a boat excursion to encounter them in their natural habitat.

WHALE WATCHING

Enjoy the interaction with southern right whales in the company of the boat captain and the whale boat guide. Whale-watching season runs from mid-June to December, when approximately 2,000 southern right whales gather in these waters to breed.



PALEONTOLOGIST FOR A DAY

Become a paleontologist for a day with exclusive access to the Egidio Feruglio Paleontology Museum. Explore hidden labs and fossil archives and come face to face with a 150 million year old dinosaur and other remarkable prehistoric specimens.

SNORKELING WITH SEA LIONS

Swim in the Patagonian sea, where calm waters come alive as playful sea lions join you in the water. Departing from Puerto Madryn, head to Punta Ameghino for a briefing before diving in for an unforgettable encounter with these curious and friendly marine mammals.

PERITO MORENO GLACIER

ESTANCIA NIBEPO AIKE

Step into the heart of Patagonia at Estancia Nibepo Aike, a traditional sheep and cattle ranch nestled within the breathtaking landscapes of Los Glaciares National Park. Embrace authentic ranch life, surrounded by mountain views and the warm hospitality that defines the Patagonian spirit.

MINI GLACIER TREK

Enjoy a scenic sail along the southern face of the Perito Moreno Glacier, followed by a short trek to a remote lakeside shelter.
