



CHINITNA BAY BEAR VIEWING

Fly over stunning landscapes on a shared flight to Chinitna Bay in Lake Clark National Park, home to a great number of brown bears. Travel aboard a 4WD bus to see the bears dig for clams, lounge on the beach, or graze in meadows. Admire the impressive males and playful cubs, then relax on your return flight to Anchorage with views of the Aleutian Range.




PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND GLACIER & WILDLIFE CRUISE

From the tiny port of Whittier, embark on a private small-boat cruise through Prince William Sound. See tidewater glaciers, scenic shorelines, bird rookeries, and search for whales, sea otters, seals, and puffins. Try fishing for salmon or black cod, then enjoy a beachside fire as your captain grills your fresh catch.

ALYESKA SCENIC TRAM

The summit viewing deck provides panoramic views of majestic mountains, hanging glaciers, sparkling streams, towering spruce and an array of wildlife.

While on the mountain enjoy hiking, berry picking or just relax and admire the view.




SPENCER GLACIER RAFT OR KAYAKING

Board the Alaska Railroad's Coastal Classic for a scenic journey to Spencer Glacier. Paddle among icebergs on a serene glacial lake, the only place in Alaska where this experience is possible.

After lunch, enjoy a 7 miles (11.26 km) float down the Placer River, keeping watch for wildlife along the banks.




DENALI FLIGHTSEEING WITH GLACIER LANDING

Take a flightseeing tour from Talkeetna to within 6 miles (9.66 km) of Denali, North America's highest peak. Fly over snow-capped mountains, glacierfilled valleys, and see Ruth Glacier and the granite walls of the Great Gorge. The highlight: land on a glacier to experience the Alaska Range's solitude.



Hike Talkeetna's best trail with a local naturalist guide, perfect for those looking to leave town behind and connect with nature. Learn about Alaska's flora, fauna and local history as you walk through lush old-growth forest, where moose, bears and birds are often seen. With Denali towering in the distance, the trail comes alive with songbirds and beautiful wildflowers.





DRYLAND DOG MUSHING TOUR


Visit the Talkeetna kennels of Iditarod champion Dallas Seavey for a dryland mushing tour. Meet the dogs, including this year's puppies and learn how these canine athletes are raised and trained. Hear what it takes to win the world's most iconic dogsled race, then climb aboard a wheeled racing rig used to train dog teams without snow.


WILDERNESS JETBOAT EXCURSION


ALCATRAZ ISLAND



Your instructor will teach you to pop up, catch a wave, and ride it to shore. Tailored to all skill levels, this promises fun at Santa Monica Beach.





Explore peaceful, lesstraveled areas of Jackson Hole on foot, with insights into the flora, fauna, geology, and history of the Greater Yellowstone area.


WILDLIFE IN THE GRAND TETONS




SNAKE RIVER FLOAT



BIKING TOUR IN GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK





breathtaking viewpoints.


RAFTING IN WESTWATER CANYON

Renowned for its remoteness and natural beauty, this stretch of the Colorado River, proposed for Wild and Scenic River status, winds through the sandstone cliffs of Westwater Canyon and into the narrow Black Granite Gorge. Here, the river crashes against canyon walls, creating thrilling rapids such as Funnel Falls, Last Chance, The Steps and the Skull Rapid.




ARCHES NATIONAL PARK

Take part in a guided exploration of Arches National Park, gaining access to hidden areas rarely seen by other visitors. Home to the world's largest concentration of natural stone arches, the park showcases nature's artistry through formations sculpted over millennia by wind and water. Hike to the iconic Delicate Arch and uncover the region's unique geology and the stories of the people who once inhabited this land.

CATHEDRAL VALLEY 4X4 ADVENTURE

Embark on a 4x4 adventure through Cathedral Valley in Capitol Reef National Park. Located in Utah's southcentral desert, the park surrounds the Waterpocket Fold, a striking geologic wrinkle with golden sandstone, canyons, and rock formations. Highlights include the Bentonite Hills, Gypsum Sinkhole, Upper and Lower South Desert, and the Temples of the Sun and Moon.



Experience a float trip through the Fishers Tower section of the Colorado River. Navigate gentle rapids as you drift past stunning red rock formations, including Fishers Towers, Castle Rock and the Priest and Nuns. This iconic place has also been the setting for many western movies.





CANYONLANDS NATIONAL PARK

Begin your journey in Utah's largest national park. Nestled in the high desert, Canyonlands is divided into four districts by the Green and Colorado rivers. Its landscape of deep canyons, towering spires, white cliffs, and majestic buttes offers breathtaking views.
